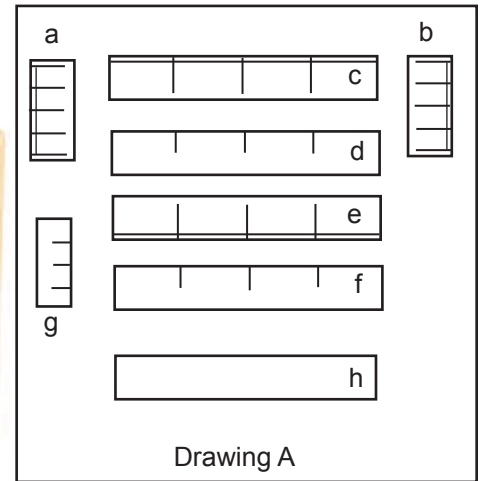
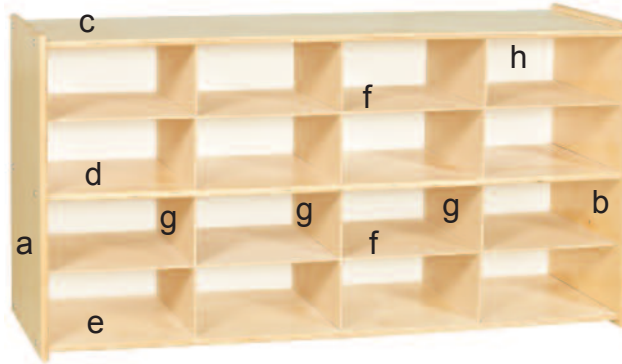

- 1 - Take the parts ie: L/R Sides, Top, Middle, Bottom, Partitions, Shelves and lay flat on the floor as shown in Drawing A
- 2 - Take side (a) and turn on its edge so the 1/4" narrow groove is facing up and front edge is down.
- 3 - Place the middle shelf (d) (slots in shelf should face towards back of unit) and bottom piece (e) into side (a) one at a time, making sure it fits into the wide grooves and that the 1/4" narrow groove in bottom (e) lines up with the 1/4" narrow groove inside (a). Screw together. ( Optional - Put a small amount of glue into the dado groove.)
- 4 - Take the top piece (c) and place it into the side piece (a) making sure all grooves line up. Screw together.  
( Do not put the other side piece (b) on at this time.) ( Optional - Put a small amount of glue into the dado groove.)
- 5 - While unit is on it's face, slide the 2 - 1/4" hardboard shelves (f) into the slots on side (a) make sure slots are facing to back.
- 6 - Take the 3 - 1/4" hardboard partitions and slide them into the top and bottom grooves and the slots in the inside shelves.
- 7 - Take the two back pieces (h) and slide them into the 1/4" narrow groove long ways, making sure the backs are all the way into the 1/4" narrow grooves all around. (You can face the white side in or out.)
- 8 - Holding the unit firmly together on the open end, flip the unit up onto side (a) (see picture Step 9 below).
- 9 - Position side (b) to line up with the top, middle, bottom, shelves and back pieces, pushing it until the pieces fit together in the grooves. Screw one screw into the top and bottom first, then screw in all remaining screws.
- 10 - Turn the unit upright and unit is ready to use.

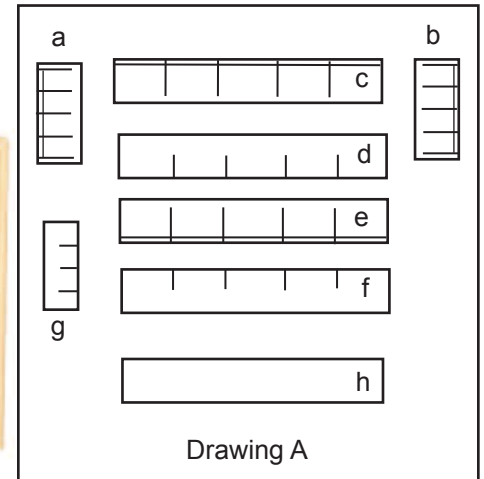
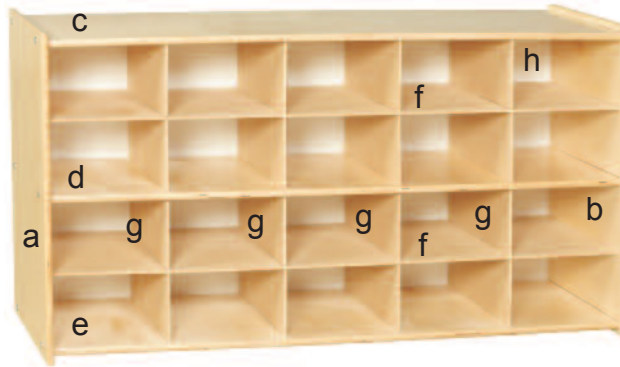

- 7 - Take the two back pieces (h) and slide them into the 1/4" narrow groove long ways, making sure the backs are all the way into the 1/4" narrow grooves all around. (You can face the white side in or out.)
- 8 - Holding the unit firmly together on the open end, flip the unit up onto side (a) (see picture Step 9 below).
- 9 - Position side (b) to line up with the top, middle, bottom, shelves and back pieces, pushing it until the pieces fit together in the grooves. Screw one screw into the top and bottom first, then screw in all remaining screws.

- 6 - Place the previously assembled middle two shelf and bottom piece into side (a), making sure it fits into the wide grooves and that the 1/4" narrow groove in (e) lines up with the 1/4" narrow groove in side (a). Screw together.
